

Documentation for Givent


1. Introduction

This documentation outlines the complete functional flow for the Click & Pledge Givent App, which helps users to understand the flow of the app.

2. Authorize Givent to Zoom account


First need to authorize our click and pledge Givent app to your zoom account so that it will be added to your account.

We can add it by visiting Zoom marketplace and search for Givent or open this link https://marketplace.zoom.us/apps/0gXX_hyPRi-bUsiyGDa6hg to add. Click on Add button, It will be redirected to authorization page.




3. Create Event/Meeting


We need to create an event/meeting in Givent settings. Fill all the required meeting details in the form and then submit it.




Once the event/meeting is created it will generate a token and will shows an email format to send email with the generated token.



Once email sent, we can see the details in the settings page including token.




User whose email has given in the event settings will receive an email containing generated token.



4. Host Token Authorization


Once host/user receives an email with authorization token he/she will start the Event

Go to Apps -> Search for the Givent App then click on the app to open it. If the logged In user is a host then he/she will need to authorize the token received in the email.

Once host authorization is successful, he/ she will be redirected to publish the donation form, so that attendees in the Event will get notified that donation form is published and can start donating.




5. Donation Form

Once the form is published, attendees can open the donation form and start filling all the required fields to donate.


